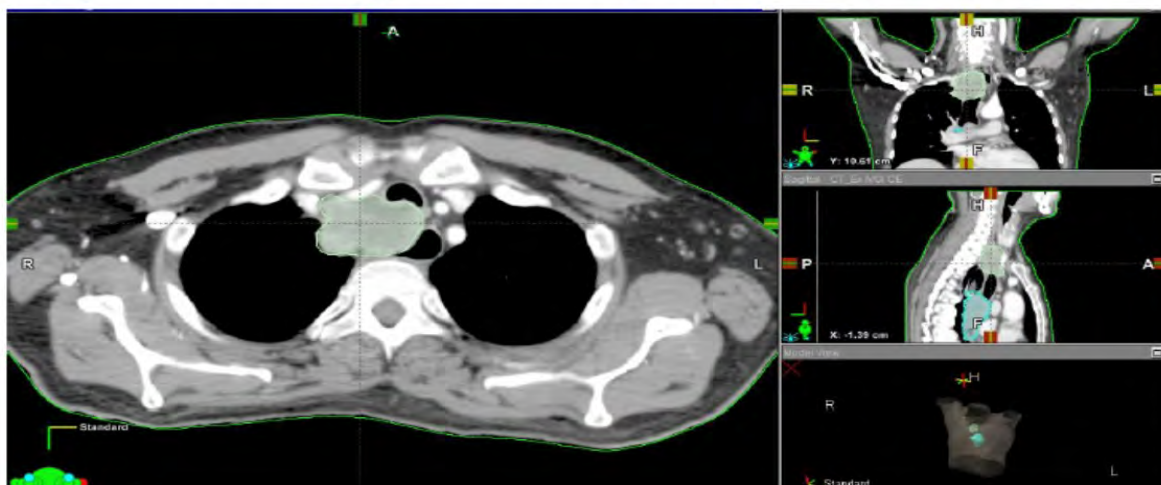

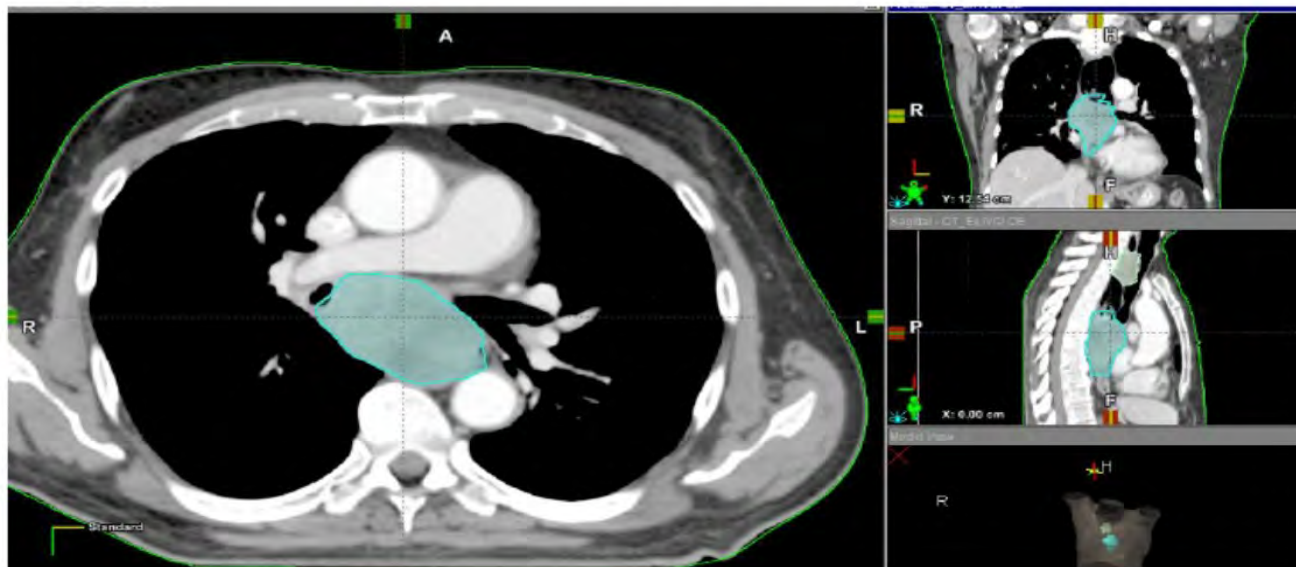

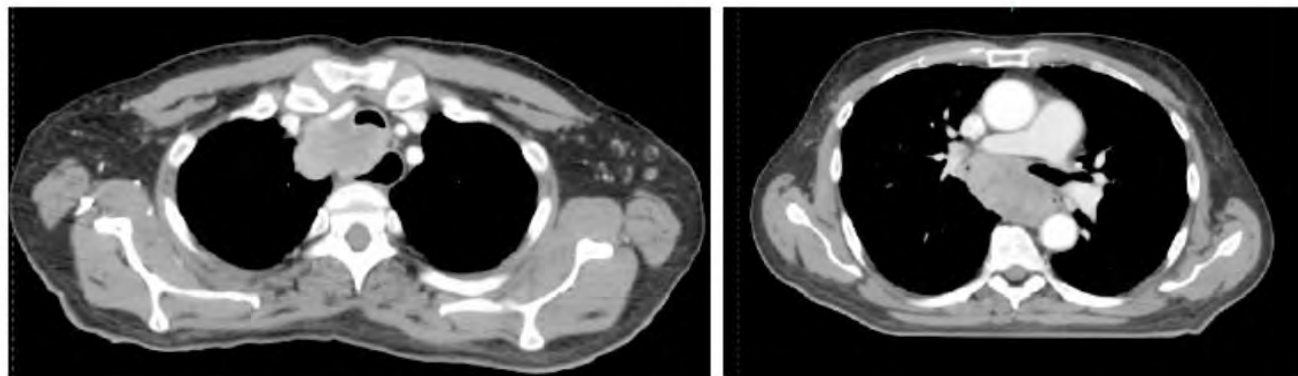
Supplement Figure 1a: 6/18/2014 Simulation



Supplement Figure 1b: 6/18/2014 Simulation

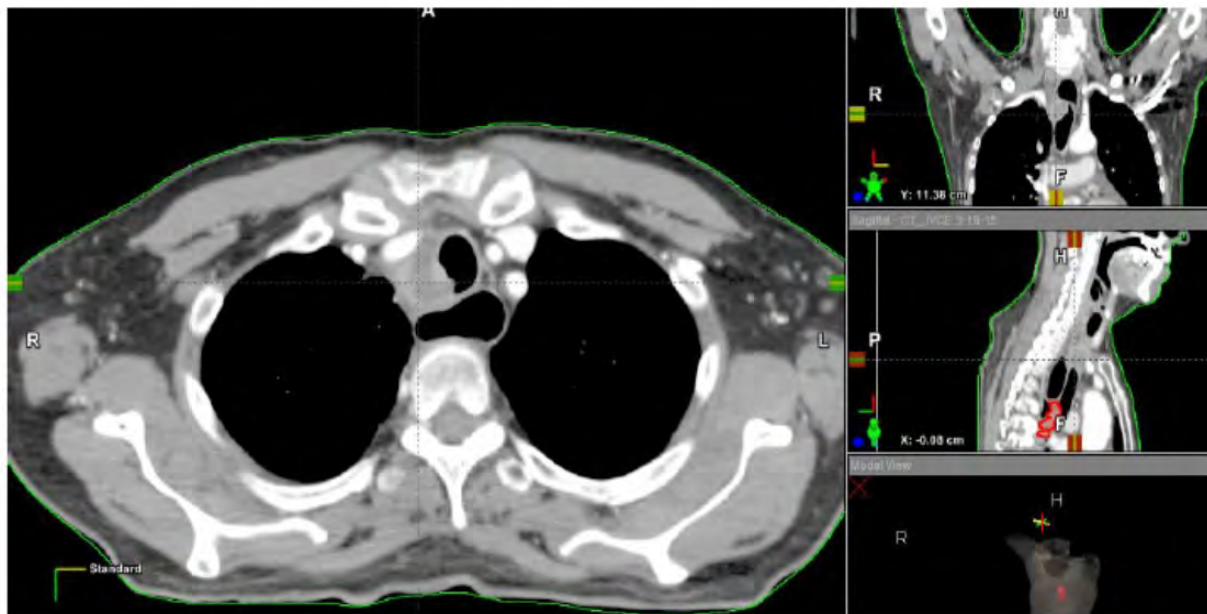


Supplement Figure 1c: 6/18/2014 Simulation

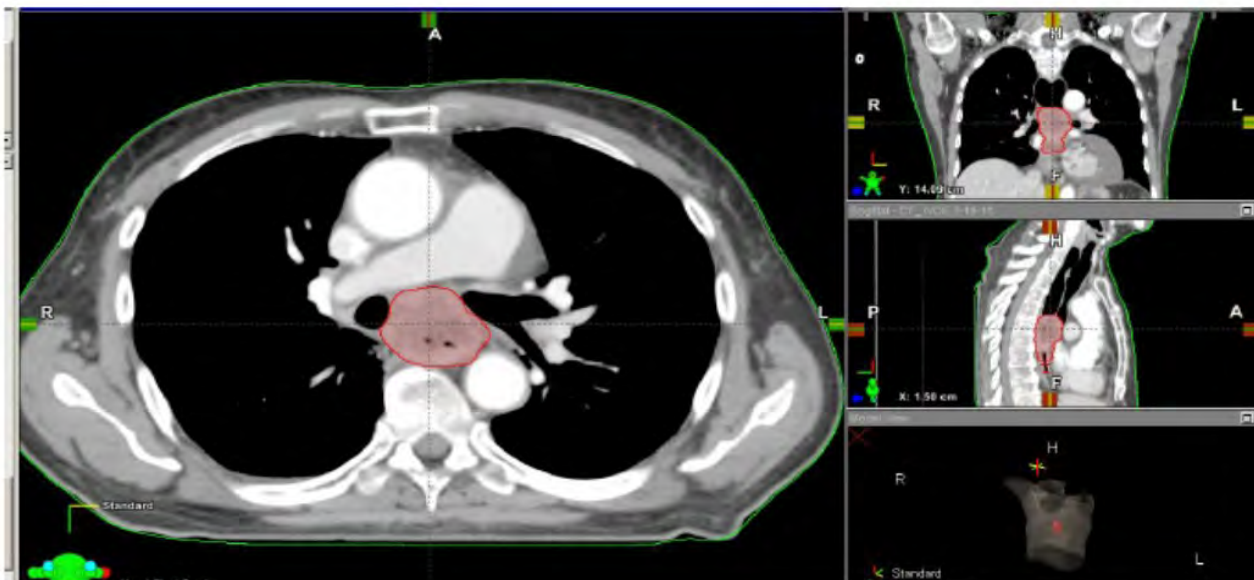


Supplemental Figure 1 (a,b,c): 6/18/14 Simulation.
